## WHAT DID WE TEACH?

This downtown Cincinnati job gave participants in the Building Value Construction Training Program an extraordinary hands-on learning experience in a heavily trafficked city environment. This included learning how to carefully load and unload trucks while navigating moving traffic and public pedestrians, which allowed them to hone skills in teamwork and safe material handling. Participants also deconstructed a wide range of electrical and plumbing systems, gaining valuable exposure to large-scale commercial components and systems. These experiences will help build a foundation of technical skills and professional standards that will guide our program participants toward long-term success.
